1. Definitions

- 1.1 "Contractor" shall mean HydroKleen Australia Pty Limited its successors and assigns or any person acting on behalf of and with the authority of HydroKleen Australia Pty Limited.
- 1.2 "Client" shall mean the Client (or any person acting on behalf of and with the authority of the Client) as described on any quotation, work authorisation or other form as provided by the Contractor to the Client.
- 1.3 "Guarantor" means that person (or persons) who agrees to be liable for the debts of the Client on a principal debtor basis.
- 1.4 "Services" shall mean all Services (including the incidental supply of goods) supplied by the Contractor to the Client and includes any advice or recommendations.
- 1.5 "Price" shall mean the price payable for the Services as agreed between the Contractor and the Client in accordance with clause 4 of this contract.

The Commonwealth Trade Practices Act 1974 ("TPA") and Fair Trading Acts ("FTA")

2.1 Nothing in this agreement is intended to have the effect of contracting out of any applicable provisions of the TPA or the FTA in each of the States and Territories of Australia, except to the extent permitted by those Acts where applicable.

3. Acceptance

- 3.1 Any instructions received by the Contractor from the Client for the supply of Services and/or the Client's acceptance of Services supplied by the Contractor shall constitute acceptance of the terms and conditions contained herein.
- 3.2 Where more than one Client has entered into this agreement, the Clients shall be jointly and severally liable for all payments of the Price.
- 3.3 Upon acceptance of these terms and conditions by the Client the terms and conditions are binding and can only be amended with the written consent of the Contractor.
- 3.4 The Client shall give the Contractor not less than fourteen (14) days prior written notice of any proposed change of ownership of the Client or any change in the Client's name and/or any other change in the Client's details (including but not limited to, changes in the Client's address, facsimile number, or business practice). The Client shall be liable for any loss incurred by the Contractor as a result of the Client's failure to comply with this clause.
- 3.5 Services are supplied by the Contractor only on the terms and conditions of trade herein to the exclusion of anything to the contrary in the terms of the Client's order notwithstanding that any such order is placed on terms that purport to override these terms and conditions of trade.
- 3.6 These terms and conditions are meant to be read in conjunction with the Terms and Conditions posted on the Contractor's website. If there are any inconsistencies between the two documents then the terms and conditions contained in this document shall prevail.

4. Price and Payment

- 4.1 At the Contractor's sole discretion the Price shall be either:
- (a) as indicated on invoices provided by the Contractor to the Client in respect of Services supplied; or
 - (b) the Contractor's quoted Price (subject to clause 4.2) which shall be binding upon the Contractor provided that the Client shall accept the Contractor's quotation in writing within thirty (30) days.
- 4.2 The Contractor reserves the right to change the Price in the event of a variation to the Contractor's quotation. Any variation from the plan of scheduled Services or specifications (including, but not limited to, additional Services required due to hidden or unidentifiable difficulties beyond the control of the Contractor or as a result of increases to the Contractor in the cost of materials and labour) will be charged for on the basis of the Contractor's quotation and will be shown as variations on the invoice. Payment for all variations must be made in full at their time of completion.
- 4.3 In the event the Client requests additional Services after the acceptance of the Client's quotation for the planned scheduled Services, then such additional Services shall be charged for on the basis of the Contractor's hourly rate applicable. The Client agrees to provide the Contractor with written approval prior to the carrying

out the additional Services. All additional charges shall be detailed as variations and invoiced separately. Payment for all variations must be made in full at their time of completion.

- 4 At the Contractor's sole discretion:
- (a) a non-refundable deposit may be required; or
 - (b) payment shall be due on delivery of the Services; or
- (c) detailed progress payment claims may be submitted by the Contractor, in accordance with the Contractor's specified payment schedule. Such payment claims may include the reasonable value of authorised variations and the value of any goods delivered to the site but not yet installed.
- 4.5 Time for payment for the Services shall be of the essence and will be stated on the invoice or any other forms. If no time is stated then payment shall be due seven (7) days following the date of the invoice.
- 4.6 Payment will be made by cash, or by cheque, or by bank cheque, or by credit card (plus a surcharge of up to two and a half percent (2.5%) of the Price), or by direct credit, or by any other method as agreed to between the Client and the Contractor.
- 4.7 GST and other taxes and duties that may be applicable shall be added to the Price except when they are expressly included in the Price.

5. Delivery of Services

- At the Contractor's sole discretion delivery of the Services shall take place when the Client takes possession of the Services at the Client's nominated address.
- 5.2 At the Contractor's sole discretion the costs of Delivery are included in the Price.
- 5.3 Delivery of the Services to a third party nominated by the Client is deemed to be delivery to the Client for the purposes of this agreement.
- 5.4 The failure of the Contractor to deliver shall not entitle either party to treat this contract as repudiated.
- 5.5 The Contractor shall not be liable for any loss or damage whatsoever due to failure by the Contractor to deliver the Services (or any of them) promptly or at all where due to circumstances beyond the control of the Contractor.

6. Risk

- 5.1 All risk for the Services passes to the Client on delivery.
- 6.2 The Client shall be responsible for any additional consumables supplied by the Contractor after delivery of the Services unless agreed by the Client and the Contractor at the time of guotation.

Employees of the Contractor

- 1 The Client agrees not to employ, contract, subcontract or utilise in any way an employee or past employee of the Contractor (other than through the Contractor) within twelve (12) months of that employee's last employment with the Contractor.
- 2 The Client agrees that if clause 7.1 is contravened the Contractor will be able to invoice the Client at its current hourly rate the hours that the employee has been employed, contracted, subcontracted or utilised in any way by the Client and agrees to pay said invoice in accordance with the standard payment terms contained in this contract.

3. Title

- 3.1 The Contractor and the Client agree that ownership of the Services shall not pass until:
 - (a) the Client has paid the Contractor all amounts owing for the particular Services; and
 - (b) the Client has met all other obligations due by the Client to the Contractor in respect of all contracts between the Contractor and the Client.
- Receipt by the Contractor of any form of payment other than cash shall not be deemed to be payment until that form of payment has been honoured, cleared or recognised and until then the Contractor's ownership or rights in respect of the Services shall continue.
- 8.3 It is further agreed that:
 - (a) until such time as ownership of the Services shall pass from the Contractor to the Client the Contractor may give notice in writing to the Client to return the Services or any of them to the Contractor. Upon such notice the rights of the Client to obtain ownership or any other interest in the Services shall cease.

(b) if the Client fails to return the Services to the Contractor then the Contractor or the Contractor's agent may enter upon and into land and premises owned, occupied or used by the Client, or any premises as the invitee of the Client, where the Services are situated and take possession of the Services.

9. Errors and Omissions

The Client shall inspect the Services on delivery and shall within seven (7) days of delivery (time being of the essence) notify the Contractor of any alleged defect, shortage in quantity, errors, omissions or failure to comply with the description or quote. The Client shall afford the Contractor an opportunity to inspect the Services within a reasonable time following delivery if the Client believes the Services are defective in any way. If the Client shall fail to comply with these provisions, the Services shall be conclusively presumed to be in accordance with the terms and conditions and free from any defect or damage. For defective Services, which the Contractor has agreed in writing that the Client is entitled to reject, the Contractor's liability is limited to either (at the Contractor's discretion) replacing the Services or rectifying the Services except where the Client has acquired Services as a consumer within the meaning of the Trade Practices Act 1974 (CWIth) or the Fair Trading Acts of the relevant state or territories of Australia, and is therefore also entitled to, at the consumer's discretion either a refund of the purchase price of the Services, or rectification of the Services, or replacement of the Services.

10. Default and Consequences of Default

- 10.1 Interest on overdue invoices shall accrue daily from the date when payment becomes due, until the date of payment, at a rate of two and a half percent (2.5%) per calendar month (and at the Contractor's sole discretion such interest shall compound monthly at such a rate) after as well as before any judgment.
- 10.2 In the event that the Client's payment is dishonoured for any reason the Client shall be liable for any dishonour fees incurred by the Contractor.
- 10.3 If the Client defaults in payment of any invoice when due, the Client shall indemnify the Contractor from and against all costs and disbursements incurred by the Contractor in pursuing the debt including legal costs on a solicitor and own client basis and the Contractor's collection agency costs.
- 10.4 Without prejudice to any other remedies the Contractor may have, if at any time the Client is in breach of any obligation (including those relating to payment), the Contractor may suspend or terminate the supply of Services to the Client and any of its other obligations under the terms and conditions. The Contractor will not be liable to the Client for any loss or damage the Client suffers because the Contractor has exercised its rights under this clause.
- 10.5 If any account remains overdue after thirty (30) days then an amount of the greater of twenty dollars (\$20.00) or ten percent (10%) of the amount overdue (up to a maximum of four hundred dollars (\$400.00)) shall be levied for administration fees which sum shall become immediately due and payable.
- 10.6 Without prejudice to the Contractor's other remedies at law the Contractor shall be entitled to cancel all or any part of any order of the Client which remains unfulfilled and all amounts owing to the Contractor shall, whether or not due for payment, become immediately payable in the event that:
 - (a) any money payable to the Contractor becomes overdue or in the Contractor's opinion the Client will be unable to meet its payments as they fall due; or
 - (b) the Client becomes insolvent, convenes a meeting with its creditors or proposes or enters into an arrangement with creditors, or makes an assignment for the benefit of its creditors; or
 - (c) a receiver, manager, liquidator (provisional or otherwise) or similar person is appointed in respect of the Client or any asset of the Client.

11. Security and Charge

- 11.1 Despite anything to the contrary contained herein or any other rights which the Contractor may have howsoever:
 - (a) where the Client and/or the Guarantor (if any) is the owner of land, realty or any other asset capable of being charged, both the Client and/or the Guarantor agree to mortgage and/or charge all of their joint

- and/or several interest in the said land, realty or any other asset to the Contractor or the Contractor's nominee to secure all amounts and other monetary obligations payable under these terms and conditions. The Client and/or the Guarantor acknowledge and agree that the Contractor (or the Contractor's nominee) shall be entitled to lodge where appropriate a caveat, which caveat shall be withdrawn once all payments and other monetary obligations payable hereunder have been met.
- (b) should the Contractor elect to proceed in any manner in accordance with this clause and/or its subclauses, the Client and/or Guarantor shall indemnify the Contractor from and against all the Contractor's costs and disbursements including legal costs on a solicitor and own client basis.
- (c) the Client and/or the Guarantor (if any) agree to irrevocably nominate constitute and appoint the Contractor or the Contractor's nominee as the Client's and/or Guarantor's true and lawful attorney to perform all necessary acts to give effect to the provisions of this clause 11.1.

12. Compliance with Laws

- 12.1 The Client and the Contractor's shall comply with the provisions of all statutes, regulations and bylaws of government, local and other public authorities that may be applicable to the Services.
- 12.2 The Client agrees that the site will comply with any occupational health and safety laws relating to building/ construction sites and any other relevant safety standards or legislation.

13. Cancellation

- 1.1 The Contractor may cancel any contract to which these terms and conditions apply or cancel delivery of Services at any time before the Services are delivered by giving written notice to the Client. On giving such notice the Contractor shall repay to the Client any sums paid in respect of the Price. The Contractor shall not be liable for any loss or damage whatsoever arising from such cancellation.
- 3.2 In the event that the Client cancels delivery of Services the Client shall be liable for any loss incurred by the Contractor (including, but not limited to, any loss of profits) up to the time of cancellation.

14. Privacy Act 1988

- 14.1 The Client and/or the Guarantor/s (herein referred to as the Client) agree for the Contractor to obtain from a credit reporting agency a credit report containing personal credit information about the Client in relation to credit provided by the Contractor.
- 14.2 The Client agrees that the Contractor may exchange information about the Client with those credit providers either named as trade referees by the Client or named in a consumer credit report issued by a credit reporting agency for the following purposes:
 - (a) to assess an application by the Client; and/or
 - (b) to notify other credit providers of a default by the Client; and/or
 - (c) to exchange information with other credit providers as to the status of this credit account, where the Client is in default with other credit providers; and/or
 - (d) to assess the creditworthiness of the Client.
 - The Client understands that the information exchanged can include anything about the Client's creditworthiness, credit standing, credit history or credit capacity that credit providers are allowed to exchange under the Privacy Act 1988.
- 14.3 The Client consents to the Contractor being given a consumer credit report to collect overdue payment on commercial credit (Section 18K(1)(h) Privacy Act 1988).
- 14.4 The Client agrees that personal credit information provided may be used and retained by the Contractor for the following purposes (and for other purposes as shall be agreed between the Client and Contractor or required by law from time to time):
 - (a) the provision of Services; and/or
 - (b) the marketing of Services by the Contractor, its agents or distributors; and/or
 - (c) analysing, verifying and/or checking the Client's credit, payment and/or status in relation to the provision of Services; and/or

- (d) processing of any payment instructions, direct debit facilities and/or credit facilities requested by the Client and/or
- (e) enabling the daily operation of Client's account and/ or the collection of amounts outstanding in the Client's account in relation to the Services.
- 14.5 The Contractor may give information about the Client to a credit reporting agency for the following purposes:
 - (a) to obtain a consumer credit report about the Client;
 - (b) allow the credit reporting agency to create or maintain a credit information file containing information about the Client.
- 14.6 The information given to the credit reporting agency may include:
 - (a) personal particulars (the Client's name, sex, address, previous addresses, date of birth, name of employer and driver's licence number;
 - details concerning the Client's application for credit or commercial credit and the amount requested;
 - (c) advice that the Contractor is a current credit provider to the Client;
 - (d) advice of any overdue accounts, loan repayments, and/or any outstanding monies owing which are overdue by more than sixty (60) days, and for which debt collection action has been started;
 - (e) that the Client's overdue accounts, loan repayments and/or any outstanding monies are no longer overdue in respect of any default that has been listed:
 - information that, in the opinion of the Contractor, the Client has committed a serious credit infringement (that is, fraudulently or shown an intention not to comply with the Clients credit obligations);
 - (g) advice that cheques drawn by the Client for one hundred dollars (\$100) or more, have been dishonoured more than once:
- (h) that credit provided to the Client by the Contractor has been paid or otherwise discharged.

15. General

- 15.1 If any provision of these terms and conditions shall be invalid, void, illegal or unenforceable the validity, existence, legality and enforceability of the remaining provisions shall not be affected, prejudiced or impaired.
- 15.2 These terms and conditions and any contract to which they apply shall be governed by the laws of Queensland and are subject to the jurisdiction of the courts of Queensland.
- 15.3 The Contractor shall be under no liability whatsoever to the Client for any indirect and/or consequential loss and/or expense (including loss of profit) suffered by the Client arising out of a breach by the Contractor of these terms and conditions.
- 15.4 In the event of any breach of this contract by the Contractor the remedies of the Client shall be limited to damages which under no circumstances shall exceed the Price of the Services.
- 15.5 The Client shall not be entitled to set off against, or deduct from the Price, any sums owed or claimed to be owed to the Client by the Contractor nor to withhold payment of any invoice because part of that invoice is in dispute.
- 15.6 The Contractor reserves the right to review these terms and conditions at any time. If, following any such review, there is to be any change to these terms and conditions, then that change will take effect from the date on which the Contractor notifies the Client of such change.
- 15.7 Neither party shall be liable for any default due to any act of God, war, terrorism, strike, lock-out, industrial action, fire, flood, storm or other event beyond the reasonable control of either party.
- 15.8 The failure by the Contractor to enforce any provision of these terms and conditions shall not be treated as a waiver of that provision, nor shall it affect the Contractor's right to subsequently enforce that provision.
